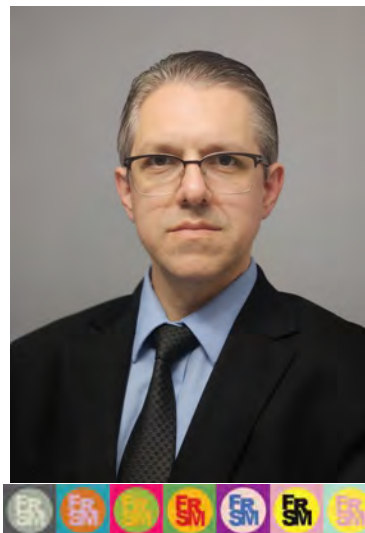
The FRSM is a registered charity. We support the Royal Saskatchewan Museum, and we have been doing so for 40 years.

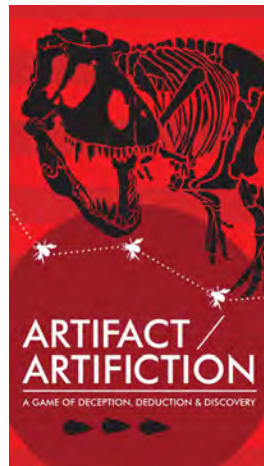


Year Five of SGI Solstice Speaker Series

Overall, the summer at TRDC was a success as people traveled to our Province and learned about the World's Largest *T. rex*! Special thanks to Jen Best and Staff!



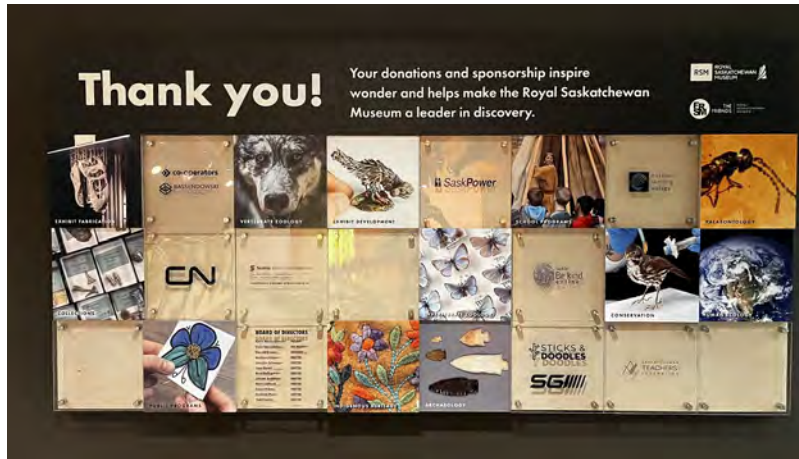
Fall 2025

Dear Friends and Supporters,

On behalf of the Royal Saskatchewan Museum (RSM), I am pleased to share highlights from a productive and successful 2025-2026 fiscal year. This past year has been marked by strong community connections, meaningful partnerships, renewed spaces, and a continued commitment to sharing Saskatchewan's rich natural and cultural heritage with diverse audiences.

Reflecting on the year, I am both grateful and proud of our shared achievements. The continued support of the Friends of the RSM has been essential in moving our mission forward and expanding our reach with visitors and communities throughout Saskatchewan. Through the dedication and hard work of staff, volunteers, and supporters, we have achieved a great deal this year.

Highlights include:

- The RSM and Friends of the RSM once again collaborated to host a highly successful, sold-out *Artifact Artifiction* event in April, raising a record-breaking amount to support RSM exhibits, research and programs.
- Museum attendance remained strong, with over 121,000 visitors, and donations increased by nearly 17 per cent per visitor, reflecting growing engagement and support.
- Visitor satisfaction reached an impressive 96.5 per cent, with 76.7 per cent reporting they were "very satisfied" and 19.8 per cent "satisfied", based on post-visit surveys.
- We received approval in the 2024-2025 budget cycle to begin construction on a new Research, Exhibits and Collections facility. This exciting project will transform an underused government building into a purpose-designed space that will significantly enhance our capacity. The new facility will provide improved environmental controls, a

safer and more efficient working environment, a proper loading dock, and expanded space for collections storage and exhibit development. Construction is underway, with completion anticipated and a potential move-in by April 2028.

- Renovations to our public washrooms were completed after nearly a year of construction, resulting in more accessible facilities and allowing us to fully restore use of our auditorium for both museum and community programming.
- New seasonal programming was introduced and warmly received, including *Halloween Boogie with Scotty's* and *Bones and Bells Holiday Party* during the holiday season.
- The Traders Exhibit in the Indigenous Gallery was renewed and updated, reopening on September 30, 2025.
- Significant progress has been made on the Indigenous Gallery renewal, a four-year project grounded in meaningful and ongoing engagement with Indigenous communities, Knowledge Keepers, and leaders. This collaborative work is shaping the themes, perspectives, and cultural framework that will guide the gallery.
- As part of this work, Métis Elder and artist Margaret Harrison joined us as Artist in Residence. She is creating a remarkable 6-by-10-foot hand-hooked rug, *The Basin of Little Things*, which will become a permanent installation in the gallery. Through public workshops and in-gallery demonstrations, visitors have been able to engage directly with her work, learning about Métis teachings, symbolism, and the revitalization of this important cultural practice.
- Our Research and Collections team has begun preparing for the future move into the new facility. With the support from the Friends of the RSM and external grants, we hired 16 students last summer to assist with collections preparation and database updates. This important work will continue in the coming year.

- In partnership with the Friends, another successful Birds *and* Bevvies event was hosted in April. Additionally, the SGI Solstice Series continues to grow in popularity and impact, further enriching our public programming.

None of these accomplishments would be possible without the dedication and support of the Friends of the RSM. We are deeply fortunate to have such a committed and passionate organization championing our work.

This spring, we recognize and thank Jennifer Schwager, who will be stepping down after completing her six-year term on the Friends Board. Her contributions, particularly in her role as Chair of the Fundraising and Communications Committee, have been invaluable. We extend our sincere appreciation for her time, leadership, and dedication to both the Friends and the RSM.

Looking ahead, we are excited to continue growing, innovating, and connecting with our communities in meaningful ways. Thank you for your ongoing support and for helping to make this work possible.
