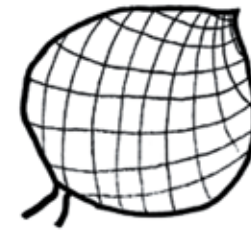
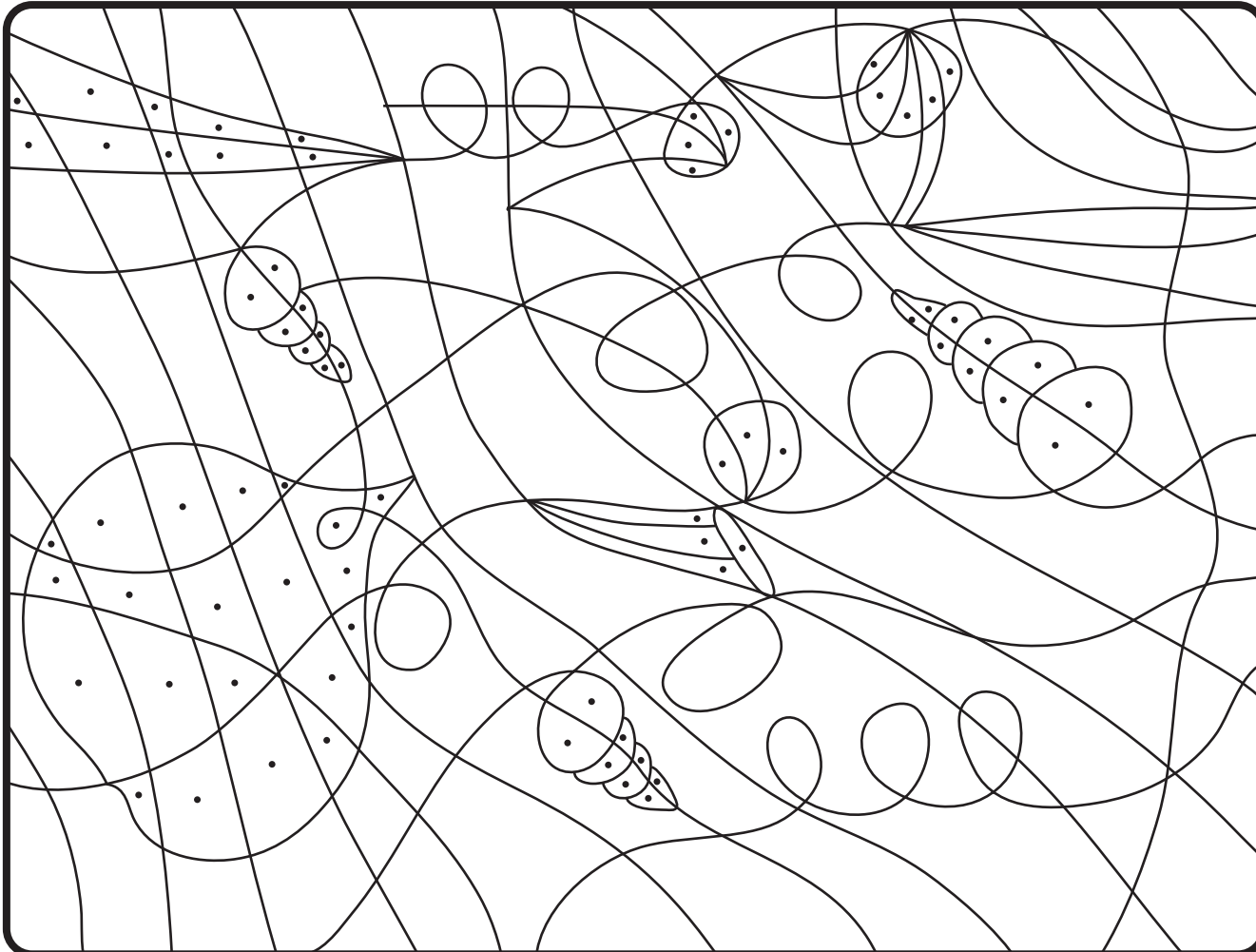


Fossil Find

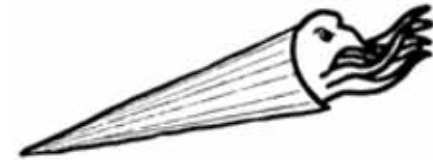
Colour the sections marked with a dot to find the fossils. Then, match the fossils to the creatures. How many of each creature did you find?

Squid (Nautiloid)

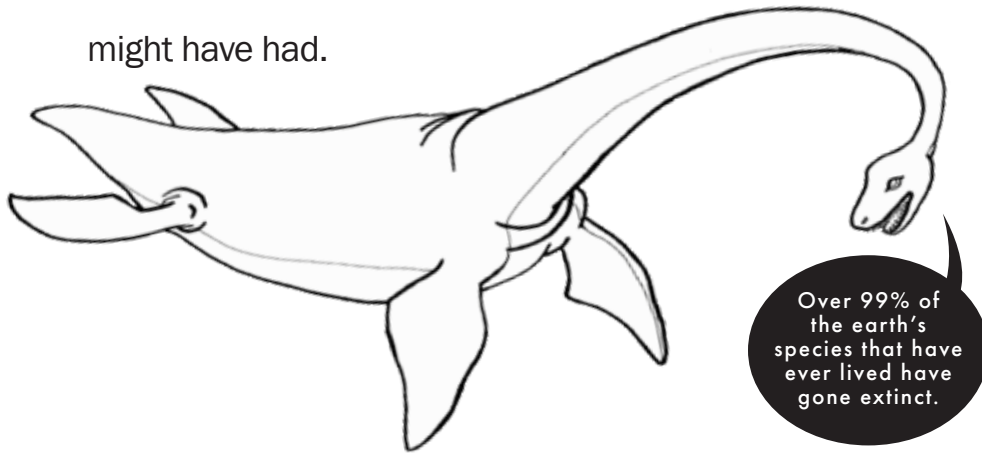

3. The markings on the Plesiosaur in the gallery are just a guess. Draw the markings you think the Plesiosaur might have had.



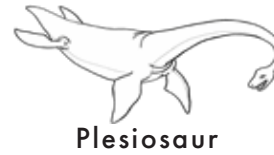
4. Find the large fossil bone hanging on the wall that says “touch me” and see what it feels like. What bone is it?

5. If dinosaurs and other prehistoric creatures were alive today what foods do you think they would like?



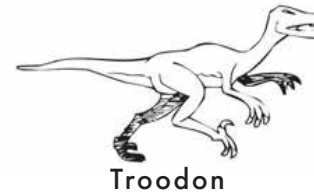

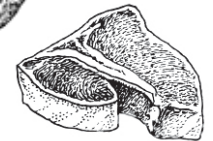
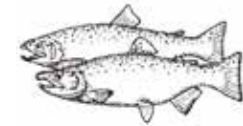
