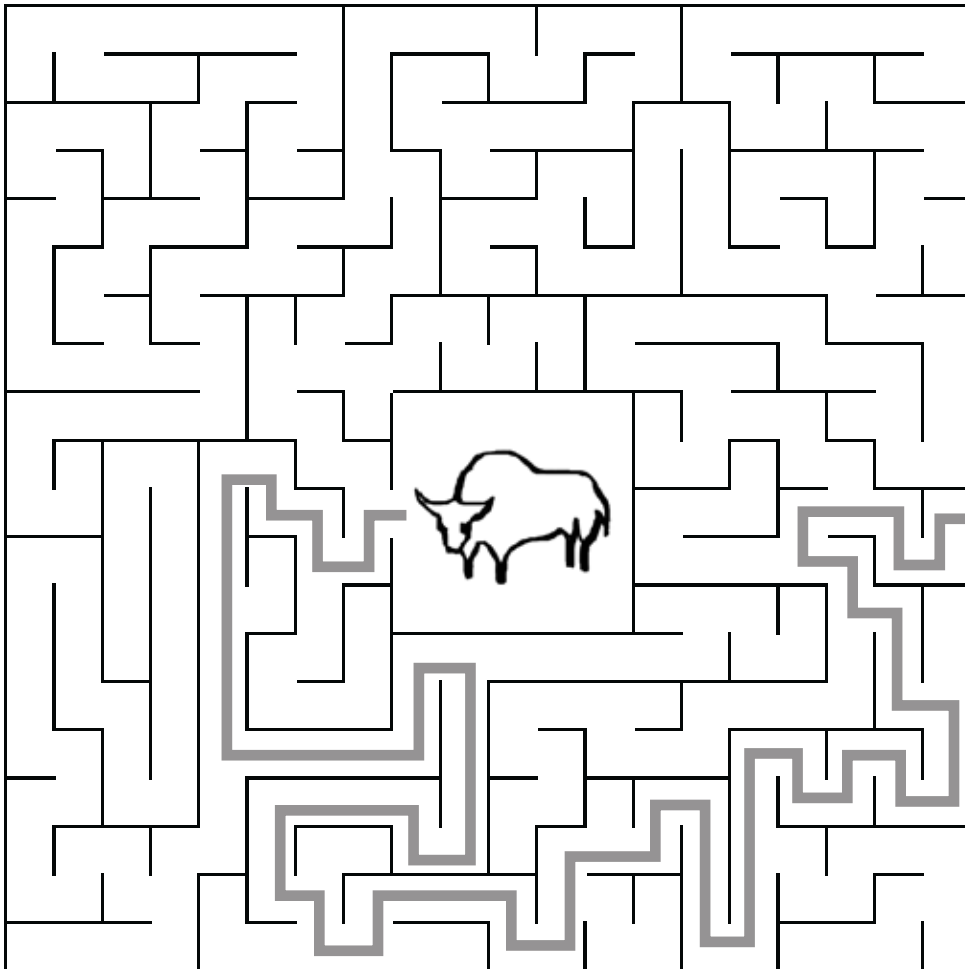


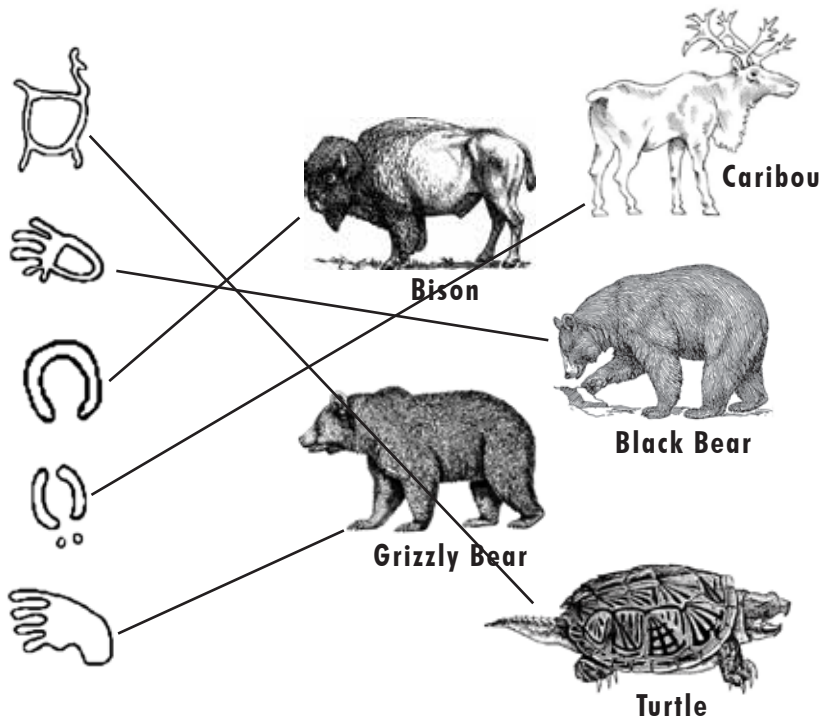
Bison Hunt

Help the hunter find the path to the bison. Once you've helped the hunter, draw an item the hunter will make from the bison.

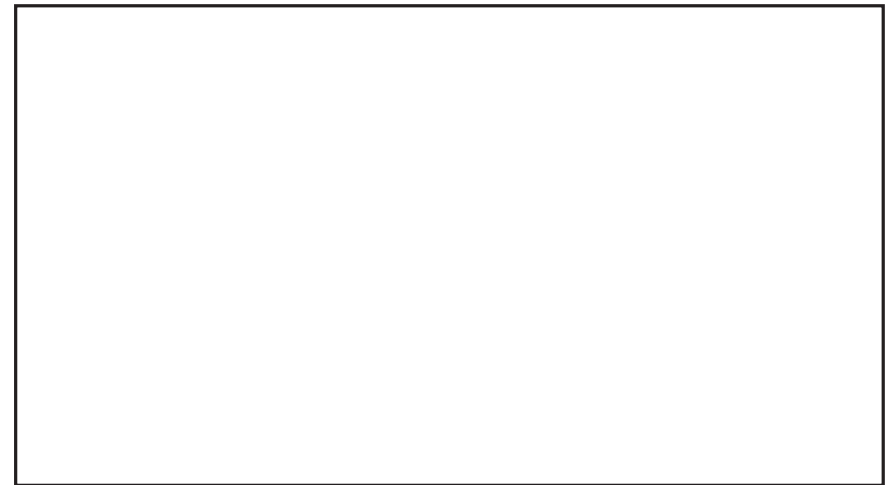


Grades K-3 | First Nations Gallery
